Dear Doctor,

Your patient was seen today in our office for a physical examination required for commercial driving. He/she was unable to meet the DOT vision requirements.

According to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, "A person is physically qualified to drive a commercial motor vehicle if that person has distant visual acuity of at least 20/40 (Snellen) in each eye with or without corrective lenses or visual acuity separately corrected to 20/40 (Snellen) or better with corrective lenses, distant binocular acuity of at least 20/40 (Snellen) in both eyes with or without corrective lenses, field of vision of at least 70 degrees in the horizontal meridian in each eye, and the ability to recognize the colors of traffic signals and devices showing standard red, green, and amber. "

In order to make a decision about your patient I need some additional information. To make reporting this information as easy as possible, I am asking you to answer the following questions, enter your office address and phone number, sign the form, and fax it back to us.
