

POST EXPOSURE LETTER OF NOTIFICATION TO EMPLOYEE

This letter is to inform you of the results of the recent tests which are required by the Bloodborne Pathogen Standards. If you have questions, please do not hesitate call Tuomey Industrial Medicine 803-778-8842.

This is the information on the source patient.

- The disease status of the source exposure is not known.
- The exposure is not likely to transmit a blood borne disease.
- The source does **not** have active Syphilis, HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, or Hepatitis C.
- The source shows evidence of possible _____.

This is the information on your tests.

- All the tests for blood borne pathogen diseases came back negative with no sign of disease.
- Your tests showed evidence of possible _____.
- Results of the repeat test for _____ were negative positive unchanged.

This is the information on your hepatitis B immunity status.

- Your Hepatitis B immunization status is adequate. You should be immune to hepatitis B.
- Your Hepatitis B immunization is inadequate.
 - A. If you have **not** had a complete Hepatitis B vaccine series, it should be completed.
 - B. If you have had the complete series this means you have only limited immunity and additional shots will generally not help.

These are our conclusions and recommendations.

- Because all of the tests from the source are negative, no follow-up testing is recommended
- I recommend that the test/s for _____ be repeated in _____ months. If the tests are negative at that time, no further follow-up will be necessary.
- This was, technically, not a blood borne pathogen exposure according to definitions published by the Centers for Disease Control. Therefore, repeat testing is not recommended. However, testing can be arranged if you have any particular concerns about your exposure.
- No additional testing is recommended at this time.
